RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 445

WHEREAS, an emergency meeting was held by Clarion Borough Council ("Council") on Saturday March 14, 2020;

WHEREAS, Council determined that the Corona virus outbreak is a threat to the health and safety of the Clarion Borough ("Borough") employees and staff;

WHEREAS, Council believes that minimizing the Borough employee's and staff's face to face contact with the public will protect their health and safety as well as potentially ensuring the continuation of Borough services to the public; and

WHEREAS, the public's ability to pay parking fines prior to the deadline of the enhanced enforcement and prosecution provisions of the Code of the Borough of Clarion ("Code") may be affected by the passage of this Resolution and a suspension of those provisions is warranted.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, and it hereby is resolved as follows:

1. Except as provided in paragraph 2 below, all Borough owned buildings will be closed to the public until further notice.
2. The opening and closing of the Clarion Free Library will be determined by the Pennsylvania Library Association.
3. Provisions 205-26, 205-60A and 205-61A of the Code are hereby suspended from enforcement until further notice.
4. This Resolution shall be effective on March 16, 2020.


