RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 447

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution No. 2020-445 in response to the Corona virus outbreak;

WHEREAS, Council has determined that while the Corona virus outbreak remains a threat to the health and safety of the Clarion Borough ("Borough") employees and staff, the threat has diminished;

WHEREAS, Council believes that re-opening Borough owned buildings with the precautions and protocols that comply with the Governor of Pennsylvania's and the Pennsylvania Secretary of Health's orders and guidance policies is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the public's ability to pay parking fines prior to the deadline of the enhanced enforcement and prosecution provisions of the Code of the Borough of Clarion ("Code") will no longer be affected and a reinstatement of those provisions is warranted.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, and it hereby is resolved as follows:

1. Resolution No. 2020 - 445 is repealed.
2. Except as provided in paragraph 3 below, all Borough owned buildings will be open to the public beginning June 3, 2020. All applicable social distancing guidelines and safety protocols (wearing a mask, etc.) shall be followed.
3. The opening and closing of the Clarion Free Library will be determined by the Pennsylvania Library Association.
4. Provisions 205-26, 205-60A and 205-61A of the Code are hereby reinstated for enforcement.
5. This Resolution shall be effective on June 3, 2020.


