

March 19, 2019, Council Meeting
Minutes

The second meeting of Clarion Borough Council was held on March 19, 2019, in the Assembly Room of the Clarion Free Library. President Lapinto called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Everyone recited the Pledge of Allegiance. ADMINISTRATION

On a motion by Mr. Aaron with a second by Dr. Sanders Dédé, approving Resolution #2019-429, approving the revised three-year Community Development Plan (DCP) for 2018 the replacement of the Neighborhood Park Project with the Main Street Improvement Project as the Borough's 2018 CDBG Activity, was carried with a vote of five yea.

PUBLIC WORKS

Mr. Noto commented next is to approve an agreement with Pennsylvania American Water relating to sewer lines in close proximity to the work the Borough will be doing with the Center Place Project. On a motion by Mr. Noto with a second by Mr. Aaron, approving the agreement for the sewer line relocation with Pennsylvania Water for Center Place Project, was carried with a vote of five yea.
