

Clarion Borough Section 3 Business and Employment Notice

The Borough of Clarion is preparing to carry out the South Sixth Avenue Reconstruction Project and the Paul A. Weaver Park Softball Field Improvements Project through the use of Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The Bid Advertisements for these projects will be published in the legal section of the Clarion News newspaper on May 5, 2022 and May 12, 2022. In accordance with United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Section 3 (24 CFR 135) regulations, Clarion Borough is hereby soliciting eligible Section 3 residents and businesses for possible employment, training and contracting opportunities related to these projects.

In the implementation of these projects the following job types, among others, may become available: Construction Laborer, Truck Driver, Excavation and Power Equipment Operators, Landscaping and Cement Mason/Finisher.

Additionally, the following contracts and procurements will or may be made: Construction Contracts for both projects, to include heavy excavation, earthwork and grading, landscaping, stormwater infrastructure installation, road reconstruction and paving, concrete curb installation, traffic control and site restoration and Construction Materials Procurement which may include, but not be limited to, bituminous asphalt and related asphalt paving products, stormwater piping, concrete inlets and related drainage materials, grass sodding and related materials, erosion and sedimentation control materials, cement and related concrete construction materials, stone and aggregates, metal fencing/barrier products and site restoration materials to include seed, mulch top soil, and related materials.

To the greatest extent feasible, employment, training and contracting opportunities will be made available to qualified Section 3 persons who permanently reside in the Borough of Clarion and to qualified Section 3 businesses located in the Borough of Clarion.
