Proposed Modification to The Borough of Clarion's
FFY 2017 Community Development Block Grant Program

The Borough of Clarion (Clarion County), in conjunction with Clarion County, proposes to modify its FFY 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. This modification process would add the Main Street Planters Installation activity. This added activity would be funded in the amount of \$45,356.87 left over from the recently completed 2017 Main Street Improvements activity. The 2017 Main Street Planters Installation activity would benefit all residents of Clarion Borough. The Borough has Low-Moderate Income (LMI) rate of 67.04% assigned to its FFY 2017 CDBG program.

The Borough of Clarion will hold a public hearing concerning this proposed modification to its FFY 2017 CDBG program at 6:00 P.M., prevailing time, on June 21, 2022, at the Ross Memorial Library Building, 644 Main Street, Clarion, PA 16214. The proposed modification will be discussed in detail, and public questions, comments, and suggestions will be invited. The Clarion Borough Council will take action on this proposed CDBG program modification at its council meeting beginning at 7:00 P.M., prevailing time, on June 21, 2022 at the above address.
