

Clarion Borough Section 3 Business and Employment Notice

The Borough of Clarion is preparing to carry out the Main Street Planters Project through the use of Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The Bid Advertisement for this project will be published in the legal section of the **Clarion News** newspaper on August 4, 2022 and August 11, 2022. In accordance with United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Section 3 (24 CFR 135) regulations, Clarion Borough is hereby soliciting eligible Section 3 residents and businesses for possible employment, training and contracting opportunities related to this project.

In the implementation of this project the following job types, among others, may become available: Construction Laborer, Electrician, Truck Driver, Excavation and Power Equipment Operators, Landscaping Laborer and Cement Mason/Finisher.

Additionally, the following contracts and procurements will or may be made: Construction Contract for the project, to include excavation, hauling, concrete construction, concrete stamping and dying/tinting, landscaping, electrical service repair and replacement, traffic control and site restoration and Construction Materials Procurement which may include, but not be limited to, concrete construction and reinforcement materials, concrete dying/tinting materials, stone and aggregates, electrical service and wiring materials, topsoil, landscaping supplies and related construction materials.

To the greatest extent feasible, employment, training and contracting opportunities will be made available to qualified Section 3 persons who permanently reside in the Borough of Clarion and to qualified Section 3 businesses located in the Borough of Clarion.
